




Autumn 1 EYFS Parent Overview

All about me!

'Flourishing together'



Topic

Our topic focus in Autumn 1 is 'All about me' the children spend time learning about each other and their teacher. We discuss how we look, what we like and dislike, our favourite, shows food, toys. We talk about family and who lives at home, we discuss where we live and what pets we have as well! The children learn rules, routine and expectations and spend time comparing home to school. Later in the term we discuss Autumn and the Harvest Festival.

Autumn Hunt

Go for a walk to look for signs of Autumn, collect different objects and create collages and portraits with them. You could practice counting with the different objects eg conkers. Can your child count accurately to 10 or higher?

Reading!

Read a book to your child daily, share their school book with them and practice their phonic sounds and words, as much as you can.

Sound hunt

Hide the flashcards around the house, can your child fin and remember the taught sounds? When out and about point out words in the environment, ask your child to find sounds they know eg. Can you find the 's' on this sign. Can you spot a 'm' nearby?


