### Year 6 SATs 2026

This letter contains important information as we prepare for this year's SATs.

SATs will take place during the week beginning **Monday 11th May 2026**. It is essential that all children attend on time every day to complete the national tests. Please arrange any appointments outside these dates or after school.

#### SATs Dates:

- Monday 11th May: English Grammar and Punctuation paper, Spelling paper.
- Tuesday 12th May: English Reading paper.
- Wednesday 13th May: Maths Arithmetic paper, Maths Reasoning paper.
- Thursday 14th May: Maths Reasoning paper.

#### Breakfast during SATs Week

All Year 6 children are invited to a SATs breakfast from Monday 11th to Thursday 14th May. The gate by the bus will open at 8:25am for Year 6 only. Breakfast will be held in the Year 6 classrooms, where pupils can enjoy a light snack (such as: cereal bars, brioche and fruit) and take part in calm, supportive activities linked to the day's test. Please ensure your child eats their usual breakfast at home. We encourage all pupils to attend and expect all Year 6 children to be in school by 8:35am during SATs week.

#### SATs Parents' Information Session

We would like to invite you to an information session on **Friday 17th April 2026**, from **3:30pm to 4:00pm** in **6R**. During this session, we will outline the SATs process and how you can support your child. This session is for parents and carers only. However, if you are unable to make alternative arrangements, children may attend provided they are able to sit quietly. A copy of the presentation will also be available to view on our school website following the session.

#### Easter Revision Homework

The children will receive an Easter Revision Homework Pack to complete over the Easter break. While we recognise the importance of rest during the holidays, it is beneficial for the children to keep practising to help maintain the progress they have made so far. The revision booklets recommend completing **10 minutes a day for 10 days**, which we hope the children will find manageable. These will also be available on our website at:
