Year 5 Visit to The British Museum

I am writing to inform you about an upcoming trip to **The British Museum in London**, which will take place on **Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2025**.

This trip will provide an excellent educational opportunity for our Year 5 students, as they explore the museum's fascinating artefacts, with a particular focus on the Ancient Greek sections. The children will take part in a workshop called "How to find out about Greek life". Focusing on enquiry skills they will study the paintings on pots, handle replica Greek objects and learn how to use them to find out about different aspects of life in ancient Greece. This visit aligns with our current history topic and will enable them to gain crucial historical knowledge about the world we live in.

The cost of the coach for this trip will be £21.96 per child. The payment can be made in **two instalments of £10.98 each** OR you can pay in full if you prefer.

We will be departing school promptly at 8.30am, so **all children need to arrive at school by 8am**, to ensure we have time to register and get the students ready to leave. We aim to be back at school by **4pm**. If we are delayed, we will be in communication with the school office who will provide you with updates. Please drop your child off and collect them from the hall, via the hall gate. Your child will need to bring a packed lunch in a disposable bag, plus a water bottle. If you are in receipt of Free School Meals, we may provide you with a packed lunch from school. If you would like to pre order a packed lunch, please complete the attached slip. This must be returned by 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2025.

Please ensure that your child wears their school uniform on the day of the trip. Additionally, they are welcome to bring a light bag to carry a colouring book or a book to read during the journey. Phones or electronic devices will not be permitted.
